



Welcome to Flying Goose Campground and Resort!
This self check-in station will help provide the information needed to find a campsite and general information about the park. Along with finding a campsite we also have firewood, mini golf, and kayak rentals available.

Step 1) Registration

1. Complete the Registration Card located at the self check in station.
2. We accept Cash, Check or Credit Card
 - a. If paying by check please include the account holders driver's license number on the check
 - b. If paying by credit card, use your cell phone camera to scan the QR code located below (Camp \$42.75/night).
3. Place the larger informational portion of the registration card in the envelope provided, seal, and drop in payment box.

Step 2) Locating your campsite

OPTION 1: (best for medium to large RVs, 5th wheels, and travel trailers)

- 100 foot EASY pull through FULL HOOK UP, 30/50 AMP, Water, Sewer - Sites marked 69-74E
- **Follow the orange road cones and select ANY OPEN SITE.**
Use your cell phone camera to scan the QR code for a video to guide you to one of these sites



OPTION 2: (Close to restroom/showerhouse best for small RVs, travel trailers, tents)

- Water and Electric Pull-through Sites 30AMP (close to shower house) - Sites marked 27-40 and 46-51
- **Follow the GREEN road cones and select ANY OPEN site**
Use your cell phone camera to scan the QR code for a video to guide you to one of these sites



Use your cell phone camera to scan the QR code to pay via credit card.

Ways to pay for firewood, mini golf or kayak rental:

- 1) Cash-fill out registration ticket and place cash and larger portion of ticket in envelope and place in drop box.
- 2) Credit card. Scan the QR code below with your cell phone and follow the online payment directions.

Policies and Guidelines

CHECK OUT: 11AM

Please notify the office before this time if you wish to stay longer. A fee of \$10 will be charged for late check out until 4pm. After 4pm, a full night fee will be charged.

Sites must be left clean of trash; including cigarette butts, nut shells, etc. Sites will be charged a \$20 clean up fee if left not picked up.

GUESTS: All guests must register in the office.

A fee of \$3 per day per person. Overnight guests will be charged \$3 per child or \$5 per adult.

SPEED LIMIT: 5mph

For the safety of our guests, we strictly enforce this speed limit throughout the campground.

TRASH: Reduce ~ Reuse ~ Recycle

Please recycle and put all commingled recyclables in a separate bag from the trash. All trash must be placed in front of your camper near the road for pick up by 10:30am.

RUGS: Save our Grass. No rugs allowed on the grass.

WI-FI: Network Name: **flying-goose** Password: **campgoose** (all lowercase)

CAMPFIRES: Do not move fire rings. No trash in fire rings.

BIKING: Daylight hours only.

ELECTRIC SCOOTERS, HOVERBOARDS, DRONES, and FIREWORKS: Not allowed in the campground.

GOLF CARTS:

Electric golf carts only. Drivers must be 16 and a licensed driver.

PETS:

Cannot be left unattended and must be leashed and well mannered. No Pets at the swim beach. Pets may swim in the lake near the office.

SWIMMING:

Swimming is permitted in the lake. You swim at your own risk. There is no lifeguard. An adult must accompany children under the age of 14.

FISHING:

Fishing is permitted in the lake at the dock area near the office. No fishing at the swim beach.

QUIET HOURS:

All minors under the age of 18 must be at their campsites by 10pm. No excessive noise is allowed at any time. Must be considerate to other campers at all times. Please contact Flying Goose Campground office or staff member if there are any problems.
